HALL of FAME

PROEDURES

- A. The Hall of Fame Committee will consist of five members selected by the CBA Hall of Fame chairperson. The chairperson will be named by the CBA Board of Directors every two years. Each year a new committee member will take the place of one current committee member as selected by the chairperson.
- B. The approval of an applicant to the 'Hall of Fame' must be (approved) by a majority of present members of the Hall of Fame Committee. Committee chairperson will not have a vote unless there is a tie.
- C Any former or current band director, staff member, judge, or CBA volunteer may submit a name and resume of any former or current band director, staff member, judge, or CBA volunteer. This must be submitted in writing to the Hall of Fame chairperson prior to May 31 of each year. The applicant's resume will remain open each year thereafter (it may also be updated).
- D. The Hall of Fame Committee will meet annually after May 31 to review the submitted names.
- E. No more (if any) than two names will be selected in any given year in the marching band area, one name in the jazz area, and one name in the CIDA area.

CRITERIA

- A. Person must be a former or current band director, staff member, judge, or CBA volunteer who participated in Cavalcade activities for at least 5 years. Activities include marching, CIDA, or jazz programs.
- C. Person must be a respected individual in his/her field of expertise.
- D. Person displayed a genuine interest in the educational development of students.
- E. Person demonstrated genuine interest through active participation in the CBA organization.

AWARD

- A. Recommended individual will be recognized at a Cavalcade Championship (either marching, CIDA, or jazz).
- B. The Cavalcade Association will provide an appropriate gift of recognition.
- C. A CBA Hall of Fame plaque will be established and displayed at all CBA Championships.
- D. The Hall of Fame members will be posted on the CBA web site.
- E. The Hall of Fame member's names will be noted in any CBA Championship program books.
