Cavalcade Jazz Festivals are sponsored by the **Cavalcade of Bands Association** which is comprised of over one hundred schools in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. The Jazz Band division of Cavalcade is in its thirty-second year of existence and has held many jazz festivals each year. We sponsor a Championship at the end of the jazz band season providing each division with at least three best soloist award medals.

The emphasis of these festivals is "Education through Music Involvement". There are no first, second, or third place bands at Cavalcade Jazz Festivals. Tonight's event recognizes the top A class and Open class bands from the circuit. We will be honoring the top performing band in each class as well as soloist from the night. The only competition is for each band to improve its performance each week.

The Cavalcade of Bands provides each festival with a panel of three professional jazz musician/educators to critique each band. Positive suggestions and constructive criticisms are given to each band from the adjudicator's digital commentary.





AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING POLICY

Personal video recording (cell phones, video camera, etc..) is **NOT PERMITTED** at championships. Each unit will be permitted to have one person to record just their band's performance at championships for educational purposes.

Anyone caught video recording at championships will be asked to stop and if they fail to cease they will be asked to leave the premises by Cavalcade staff and not refunded their ticket price.

This is to ensure Cavalcade, and all member schools, are compliant with all music, video and performance rights copyright laws. There are serious financial consequences for anyone breaking these laws which the Cavalcade Board and Administration staff fully support.
